Health & Safety:

Warehousing and distribution are often high risk areas and accident hot spots with heavy machinery and masses of activity. Therefore it is essential that correct procedural methods are followed to ensure staff safety.

The monitoring of such high risk areas including loading bays, goods inwards and transport thoroughfares ensure that staff follow the proper course of actions, as accidents occur most frequently when procedures are not followed.

Fraudulent Injury Claims:

Businesses are facing an ever increasing battle with claims for injuries due to alleged unsafe working conditions and negligence. ID's solutions have effectively reduced the number of payouts for clients by disproving unlawful and fraudulent claims through the use of high resolution CCTV imagery.

Intruder and Unauthorised Access:



ID solutions can monitor restricted areas and access points so customers know exactly who has been where, at what time and for what reason. Motion detection cameras can be placed on high value stock to combat internal theft, or snapshot technology creates a digital database of all persons entering through a specified access point. All activity can be monitored instantly on a daily or weekly basis without having to trawl through hours of unnecessary imagery or have constant 24hr monitoring.

Security or managers can be alerted by a number of methods when security points are breached, and the system can be set for any time of day so activity is only recorded at night time or when required.

Within a 24 hour manned guard centre, motion sensor and snap shot cameras have eliminated the need for intruder alarm systems. Staff can be alerted when an unauthorised or specified area has been breached through many methods, and instantly retrieve previous footage to give a full picture of the whole event and take action on a potential intruder.

Site Monitoring:

With an abundance of activity and movement going through the site, all visitors and drivers can be accounted for on entering and leaving using snapshot cameras and infrared beams; be them on foot or in a vehicle. Swipe in and swipe out points gives full data of all staff and non-staff movement accessible through one tailored system, with mustering points giving instant access to who is still in the building in the event of a fire alarm/drill.

Virtual Cage and Stock Loss

Internally and externally, 360 Pan Tilt and Zoom (PTZ) cameras give complete detailed coverage of many areas, combating internal theft and staff collusion through methods such as storing stock in other parts of the building and obtaining them at a later date. ID has introduced a virtual cage solution through the use of motion detection cameras. A "virtual area" can be set on specified perimeters covering high value stock or unauthorised locations, enabling security to be alerted to any breach of the virtual area or activity not permitted to certain hours.
